- E**njoys people, and helping them connect with one another and with Christ in a safe environment.
- A**ble to lead a group in exploring and applying God's Word and serving one another (and others).
- D**ependable team player in relationship with his/her group and the GroupLife ministry as an integral part of Christ Community. Life Group leadership isn't a solo act ☺.

Hosting a Life Group ...*

- H**as a home that can comfortably accommodate 6-12 people.
- O**versees refreshments and meals (if applicable), and helps facilitate group social gatherings.
- S**erves in partnership with the group leader in helping the group minister to one another.
- T**akes hospitality seriously, and enjoys making others feel welcomed and at home.
