

STUDENT RECOVERY PROGRAM @ GREELEY CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL

TITLE: ACADEMIC TUTOR

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: In order to focus on academic success at Greeley Central, students that participate in SRP must be provided with additional academic intervention before/after school in order to stay current on their assignments and get the help they need to learn the information correctly. In order for this intervention strategy to be effective the tutor to student ratio must be no great than 1:3. Tutors are recruited through UNC, AIMS, and within District 6 on a volunteer basis.

FUNCTION SUMMARY: Tutoring should be provided at least three times a week after school at a predetermined location, during the time slot of 3:15-4:30 pm. Volunteer tutors could volunteer one, two, or three days per week. Home visits are completed prior to initiating the after school program in order to get parent and student agreement. Students must attend mandatory tutoring sessions when their grades fall below a "C." Grades are monitored daily by pre-assigned case managers that are on site.
