

For our in-person services we will still be socially distancing by sitting in family/group units. Masks will be required for ages kindergarten and up unless you have a medical exemption. No reservations required. Services will continue to be available online.

Guidelines and Details for in-person services

- 300-person limit for sanctuary per service.
- If you or someone in your family has been sick, please stay home.
- Seating opens 30 minutes before service start.
- Family / households / groups stay together. Spacing between groups or individuals.
 - People/Groups will be seated by a section host.
 - We cannot have individuals moving around, congregating in the lobby. This will be encouraged to happen outside or socially distanced in the sanctuary.
- Masks required for everyone (for kids kindergarten and older) indoors unless on stage or for a medical exemption.
 - People will be asked to put on masks before entering building.
 - Masks will be provided for anyone who does not have one.
 - Anyone refusing to wear a mask will be asked not to enter the building.
 - We will require everyone to wear a mask the entire time while indoors.
- To help with flow, everyone will enter the building through the East main lobby doors.
- Traditions congregation will continue to meet at 8:30 am on Sunday's mornings. They will use the South Office Door.
- CC Spanish will continue to meet at 1:00 pm on Sunday afternoons.

Kids Ministry Information

If you are not comfortable coming to an in-person service, we will still be doing Tiny Tots, CCKids and Loop services online.

- Room capacities are significantly smaller than pre-covid. All capacities will be based on room square-footage and volunteer ratios.
 - There is not a reservation system. Any families wishing to utilize Tiny Tots, CCKids and Loop ministries will be able to check their child into these ministries as long as the room capacity has not been reached.
 - If the Children's Ministry areas reach capacity, kids will be given the opportunity to attend the service with their family.
- All room leaders and volunteers will be wearing masks for the entire service.
 - Kids ages kindergarten and up will be asked to wear a mask in the building.
- All volunteers will be washing their hands upon entering the room.
 - Tiny Tots will wash their hands upon entering the room.
 - CCKids and Loop ages will be asked to wash their hands in one of the lobby restrooms before entering the Playhouse.
 - Hand sanitizer will be available for use with adult supervision.

- We will be sanitizing the children's areas before each service. Our rooms will open approximately 15 minutes before the service starts.
- **Check-in will be assisted by a ministry volunteer.**
 - Temperatures will be taken and a symptom check will be reviewed before your child will be checked-in.
 - Tiny Tots parents will check-in their child in the lobby area. Then a Tiny Tots Leader will walk the child to their classroom.
 - CCKids and Loop will be checked-in by the fireplace in the lobby. Parents can let their children walk up the stairs to the Playhouse unaccompanied or parents can accompany their child to the Playhouse entrance using the stairs behind the fireplace. Parents will be asked to stay in the Playhouse lobby and then exit onto the Mezzanine.
- **Picking up your children.**
 - To ease congestion, we are asking that only 1 parent come to pick up their Tiny Tots kids in the Tiny Tots lobby; no parents will be walking down the Tiny Tots hallway. Your child will be lined up and ready for you.
 - CCKids and Loop will be outside the building in front of the Playhouse weather permitting. A fence will surround the area and no parents will be allowed inside the fence. Children will be brought to the gate for parent pick-up.
